Cost for schools within 30 miles of Bethesda (LL57 3EU) is £180 for one class (<30 pupils) for half a day or if you have two classes £300 for a whole day (half day each). Small schools that are very close to each other could combine in order to book a whole day between you.

During the workshop, I will use physically active and creative methods to facilitate learning about the mammals of the Welsh woods in a fun way.

There will be an emphasis on the relationship between red squirrels, grey squirrels and pine martens, we will also learn about suitable woodland habitats for dormice and bats.

Access to the web and a large screen will be required for the initial presentation. Then we will need an area with enough space for us to move around e.g. hall or outside area (depending on the weather).

It is possible to adapt the workshop for pupils aged 11-14.
